



Guidelines for Presentations

1. **Choosing a topic** – your topic should be based on existing and past work done by your organization that is spatially-based e.g. GIS in Addressing Threats from Natural Disasters, or Importance of the NSDI in Managing Belize’s Protected Areas. See list below showing invitees’ subject areas that we would like to learn more about.

2. **Timing your presentation** – each presenter is allotted 30 minutes for their presentation. 20 minutes for the presentation (more or less 20 Power Point slides).

3. **Presenting** – each presenter should submit their presentation at registration (8:30 – 9:00AM) on Wed 9th November. The proposed schedule for presentations will be submitted in the draft agenda on 14th October, 2011. We will have available projector and laptop for the presentations.
